We were able to find a few additional new things - malachite on olivenite with cornwellite from Brazil and a new find of very good new eosphorites from Brazil; a new find of fluorite from New Mexico; a collection of rare minerals from Utah; phantom dolomite from Brazil; very good clear stokesite on the white(two generation)l; galena on chalcopyrite, odd quartz, japanese twin interferrence quartz from Dal'negorsk, Russia; citrine from the Ural Mts, Russia; a superb rhodochrosite with fluorite from China; selenite from Australia; and a several others.

I will be home after 9/25/06 and will start posting specimens after that date.
