New Goethite from Ukraine

Excellent goethite specimens comprise the new [Goethite Update \(click here\)](#) I've just added on the website. Although goethite is a common mineral, it is uncommon to find collection-worthy specimens (most goethite is terribly ugly). These are beautiful for the species.

These goethite specimens were recently found in one of the huge chamber pegmatites at Volodarsk-Volynskii (long famous for fantastic beryls, large topaz crystals and monster quartz crystals. Current work at this mine complex has been largely curtailed and it is not

clear whether any significant further work will be economically feasible. Prior to discontinuing most operations, the mining workings intersected a pocket which contained these radial groups of goethite crystals. I acquired them from the person who mined them out before the water table was allowed to submerge the pocket.
